

# Chronology of the Four Gospels

Much of this chronology follows that in *The Narrated Bible* by F. LaGard Smith, though I have made some adjustments of my own. (See [Aschmann.net/BibleChronology/#Sources](http://Aschmann.net/BibleChronology/#Sources) for more information.)<sup>1</sup> The page numbers in the last column are from that book. (When I have changed the order these are marked in green.)

Red: date or timespan provided in the text, or that can be calculated from it. The text that provides it is also in red.<sup>2</sup>

**Bold and outlined**: the most complete or key passage.

**Blue outline**: passages outside the four gospels.
