Chronology of the Four Gospels

Much of this chronology follows that in *The Narrated Bible* by F. LaGard Smith, though I have made some adjustments of my own. (See <u>Aschmann.net/BibleChronology/#Sources</u> for more information.)¹ The page numbers in the last column are from that book. (When I have changed the order these are marked in green.)

Red: date or timespan provided in the text, or that can be calculated from it. The text that provides it is also in red.²

Bold and outlined: the most complete or key passage.

Blue outline: passages outside the four gospels.

Yellow background: passages that are not in chronological order in one of the gospels (or at least that *The Narrated Bible* organized in a different order).³ Sky-blue background: passages that are arranged in a different order merely for organizational reasons, not because of a real chronological problem.
